demonstrating them the adverse effect of plastics and how it's harmful for the nature.


Some of them chanted out strong appealing slogans and effective messages on anti-



'Energy conservation is the need of the hour' - Dr. N. S. lingayat Webinar Organized On 'Energy Conservation' At Comrade Godavari Shamrao Parulekar College, Talasari

NSS department of Comrade Godavari Shamrao Parulekar College, Talasari organized a one-day webinar on 'Energy Conservation and Solid Waste Management on 1st September 2021, Dr. N. S. Lingayat was present as the keynote speaker and guide of this webinar. The webinar was organized on Google Meet in a virtual manner.

At the beginning of the event, NSS program Officer Prof. Dipak Wakde introduced all the dignitaries present and explained the purpose of organizing the Webinar. Principal Dr. B. A. Rajput inaugurated Webinar and highlighted the purpose of the Webinar and various activities of the college. He asserted that in modern times, while the whole world is being powered with the help of energy, there is a need to conserve more energy and make an important contribution to it.

Dr. Nitin Shivappa Lingayat of the external faculty of PCRA guided the students in Webinar. Starting with the current energy situation, Dr. Lingayat explained the need for clean energy sources. In the first part of the Webinar, the basics of various clean energy sources such as solar, wind, geothermal, wave were discussed. Awareness program on 'Waste Management and Waste to Best' organized at Comrade Godavari Shamrao Parulekar College, Talasari

National Service Scheme Department of Comrade Godavari Shamrao Parulekar College, Talasari organized a one-day awareness program on 'Waste Management and Waste to the Best' on 24th December 2021, For the event, Sunny Rai, Mahatma Gandhi Disability Training Center, Ahmedabad, Gujarat provided various demonstrations on how to manage waste and how to make beautiful handicrafts from raw materials.

Speaking on the occasion, NSS Program Officer Prof. Dipak Wakde said that in the daily life of a person, different types of solid waste are generated. It mainly consists of kitchen waste, gift house waste, etc. The amount of this solid waste is increasing day by day. Growing urbanization has created various environmental problems today, including solid waste disposal, which has become a major environmental issue.

The need of the hour is to find a solution to this solid waste problem through public participation and implement it properly. With this in mind, the government has launched a very effective scheme called Sant Gadge Baba Nagari Swachhta Abhiyan. Citizens need to show their participation in that. Solid waste generation in cities is becoming a complex and serious issue. If you think about the whole world, it is estimated that about 100 billion tons of waste are generated every year. If the annual waste generated around the world were collected in one place, it would become a mountain as high as Mount Everest. The United States is the world's largest producer of solid waste.

Speaking on the occasion, the keynote speaker Sunny Rai said that the beauty of the city and the village is being tarnished by the dumping of solid waste elsewhere; but it also raises a number of health issues. Fish, mosquitoes, rodents, and cockroaches are bred in large numbers at waste collection sites. A number of measures have been suggested for the proper disposal of solid waste.

The garbage generated in different parts of the city is collected, transported to a place far away from the city, where it is incinerated or used for compost manure or disposed of as such.

The need of the hour is to study the waste generated in the city as well as in the villages and how to manage and dispose of the waste properly. Garbage causes many health problems. If this problem of solid waste is not stopped in time, then future generations will have to face very big problems.

More than 50 NSS volunteer students attended the event. Prof. Ritesh Raichana thanked the audience and concluded the program with the national anthem.


